School Supplies Distribution for 2021-2022 Academic year

There will be two distribution periods this year. Please follow our dates below. We will not be holding a large event this year due to spread of the COVID-19 Delta variant. August 5-13th— High School Distribution:

The WIEC will be distributing school supplies and backpacks for Douglas High School, Aspire, and South Tahoe High School students, starting August 5th. The Center opens at 10am daily.

August 16-27th—Middle and Elementary School Distribution:

Once the survey is completed and submitted, you will have to complete a parental agreement (at the center) and sign for your student's Chromebook. A protective sleeve comes with it.

The Chromebook is your student's to keep. No need to return back to the center.

WIEC Tutoring Schedules and Expectations

The WIEC will begin its academic school year tutoring on August 9th. The Center will be open from 10am-5pm daily. We encourage anyone in need of tutoring to come to the center.

COVID-19 Protocols:

We will be enforcing temperature taking, face masks, and social distancing when in the center. Frequent hand washing and use of hand sanitizer are strongly encouraged. K-12 California schools are requiring face masks for all persons indoors, regardless of vaccination status.

As far as tutor scheduling, the only change will be in Jordan's schedule. He will only be available on a limited basis for after-school tutoring on: Mondays and Wednesdays for two hours.

Please bring all homework and textbooks for tutoring. A positive attitude and good manners are a must! If you have a laptop, please bring it along.

The Johnson O'Malley Program is available to assist American Indian/Alaska Natives students who are enrolled members of a federally recognized tribe or at least 1/4 or more degree of Indian blood descendant of a member of a federally recognized Indian tribal government eligible for services from the Bureau. In addition, eligibility requires these children be between the age 3 through grades 12, with priority given to children residing on or near an Indian reservation. The submitted applications will be reviewed and approved by the Washoe Tribe Indian Education Committee (IEC). If you have any questions or concerns regarding this application, please contact IEC.
